APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Breo Ellipta may be approved if the following criteria are met:

- I. Individual has been on Breo Ellipta in the past 180 days (medication samples/ coupons/ discount cards are excluded from consideration as a trial); **OR**
- II. Individual has a diagnosis of asthma and has had a trial and inadequate response to one oral inhaled corticosteroid (ICS) agent (examples of inhaled corticosteroids include, but are not limited to, Aerospans, Asmanex, Flovent, QVAR); (NHLBI 2007); **OR**
- III. Individual has a diagnosis of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).
