APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Sprycel (dasatinib) may be approved if the following criteria are met:

- I. Individual has a new diagnosis of Philadelphia chromosome positive (Ph+) Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia (CML) in chronic phase (label, NCCN 2A); **OR**
- II. Individual has a diagnosis of chronic, accelerated, or myeloid or lymphoid blast phase Ph+ CML with resistance or intolerance to prior therapy including imatinib (label) ; **OR**
- III. Individual has a diagnosis of CML in accelerated phase and has one of the following mutations: Y253H, E255K/V, or F359V/C/I and results are provided (NCCN 2A); **OR**
- IV. Individual has a diagnosis of Ph+ Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL) with resistance or intolerance to prior therapy (label, NCCN 2A); **OR**
- V. Individual has a diagnosis of Soft Tissue Sarcoma – Gastrointestinal Stromal Tumors (GIST) (NCCN 2A); **OR**
- VI. Individual has a diagnosis of Ph+ CML in chronic phase in children and adolescents weighing at least 10 kg (22 pounds).
