APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Venclexta (venetoclax) may be approved if the following criteria are met:

- I. Individual has a diagnosis of relapsed/refractory Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia (CLL) or Small Lymphocytic Lymphoma (SLL) with or without 17p deletion (label, NCCN 2A);

AND

- II. Individual is using in combination with rituximab;

OR

- III. Individual is using as monotherapy

OR

- IV. Individual has a diagnosis of Mantle Cell Lymphoma (NCCN 2A); **AND**

- V. Individual is using as monotherapy.

Note: Concomitant use of Venclexta (venetoclax) with strong inhibitors of CYP3A at initiation and during ramp-up phase is contraindicated.
