APPROVAL CRITERIA

Requests for Xalkori (crizotinib) may be approved if the following criteria are met:

- I. Individual has a diagnosis of Non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC), recurrent or metastatic; **AND**
- II. There is confirmation that the tumor is:
 - A. Anaplastic lymphoma kinase (ALK)-positive; **OR**
 - B. C-ros oncogene 1(ROS1) positive; **OR**
 - C. Mesenchymal-Epidermal Transition (MET) amplifications are present (NCCN 2A); **OR**
 - D. Inflammatory Myofibroblastic Tumor (IMT) with ALK translocation (NCCN 2A);
- OR**
- III. Individual has a diagnosis of Central Nervous System Cancers; **AND**
- IV. Individual has recurrent disease for brain metastases if active against the primary tumor (NSCLC) (NCCN 2A);
- OR**
- V. Individual has a diagnosis of Soft Tissue Sarcoma; **AND**
- VI. Individual is using for Inflammatory Myofibroblastic Tumor (IMT) with ALK Translocation (NCCN 2A);
- OR**
- VII. Individual has a diagnosis of Peripheral T-cell Lymphomas; **AND**
- VIII. Individual is using as monotherapy for relapsed/refractory ALK-positive anaplastic large cell lymphoma (NCCN 2A).
